REHEARSAL WEEK: DECEMBER 8TH-11TH - RMD NORTH STUDIO

Because of interactions between dancers, extra rehearsals are necessary to prepare for Snow White. In-studio rehearsals will begin Monday, December 8th, and will be held in the North Studio. All rehearsals are required. Rehearsals are **in ADDITION** to regular classes. **Dancers should attend their regular classes—even if they fall on the same day as a rehearsal.** If a rehearsal overlaps with a regular class, the rehearsal will take priority. Please read the class notes under the rehearsal times carefully, and if you are unsure of your class name check with your instructor.

Please make sure to be in the building by your arrival time planning plenty of time for parking. **We are on a tight schedule so it is extremely important to be on time.** Dancers will need to wear their costume to dress rehearsal but will not need stage makeup. Please note that these are estimated times and we may run slightly ahead or behind schedule. Please help us out with both by arriving early and being patient with pick up times.

PERFORMANCE- SATURDAY, DECEMBER 13th -GRANGER HIGH

There will be two performances of SNOW WHITE . We have divided dancers into two casts, working to get siblings in the same show *to the best of our ability*. In order to do that, several classes will perform in both shows. Cast lists are as follows:

Dancers should arrive in costume with hair and makeup done by the arrival time listed above. Pre-School students will not need to arrive until ½ hour before show time. Please do not be late as we need this time to get everyone organized. Dancers will need to stay backstage throughout the entire performance. All dancers will participate in a finale at the end of the show. Each class will be assigned a chaperone. If parents of young children feel that they need to stay with their dancer during the performance, please sign up to be a chaperone. No siblings will be allowed backstage.

We anticipate the show to last just under two hours. Immediately following the show, chaperones will take the dancers back into their dressing room to get their belongings. Young dancers will need to be checked out of the dressing room by one parent. Please do not bring additional family members into the dressing room, as it can get very congested. No males allowed in the dressing room areas.

Dancers performing in both shows will need to remain in the dressing room. (It is a quick turnaround between shows) Please bring a snack that you can have between shows. (Something that won't be scary to eat in your costumes, as we will be wearing them again in the spring) Chaperones will take them to an area where they can eat, use the restroom etc... before getting ready to begin the second show.

COSTUME, HAIR AND MAKEUP

Dancers may have received or will be receiving their costumes within the next month. Please organize your costume by labeling each piece with your child's name and storing together with all costume accessories, hair pieces etc.. Dancers will also need clean ballet tights and ballet shoes. Dancers wearing pointe shoes will need to sew their ribbons in after tying them.

HAIR SHOULD BE WORN AS FOLLOWS:

Pre-School & Pre- Ballet Classes: Curly Ringlets with sides pulled up into half ponytail, no part.

7 Dwarfs: pigtail braids (no elastic at the head only on the ends)

Leads: Individual but must be approved through Trisha

All others: Slick back ballet bun at the crown of the head. Absolutely no fly aways. Secure the pony tail at the crown then wrap the hair in 1 or 2 pieces (thicker hair it's recommended to use 2-3 strands) into a bun and bobby pin it well then cover with a hair net that matches their hair color. STAGE MAKE-UP INSTRUCTIONS:

Because of the brightness of stage lighting, all dancers including pre-school students need to wear stage make-up.

Face- Apply foundation and blend well. Use an appropriate shade of pink blush for your tone following the upper cheek bone toward the temple.

Eyes- Cover the lid and under brow bone with white or cream eye shadow then use a brown for the crease and blend out. Line the upper and lower lid with eyeliner, apply black mascara. All company students will be required to wear false eye lashes. Lightly define brows with appropriate brown tones for complexion/hair color.



Lips- Red lipstick. Line the lip with a matching red then fill in with a deep red. We recommend using smudge proof lipsticks to prevent transfer to costumes. Maybeline #20 is a suggested color match.

We will offer reserved seating again this year. Tickets will be available beginning Tuesday, December 2nd at 7:00 p.m. Early seat reservations will be offered to our chaperones and volunteers (See Below).

To reserve your seats:

- 1-Go to our website www.rockymountaindance.com
- 2- At the bottom of the home page under "Our Events" click on Tickets
- 3- You will be redirected to the site to order tickets
- 4- Follow instructions to reserve seats MAKE NOTE OF YOUR CONFIRMATION NUMBER.
- 5- Tickets will need to be paid for at the time of ordering through PAYPAL (RMD online payment may not be used to order tickets)
- 5- Print tickets from home and bring to the performance

-If you do not have a paypal account you will need to set one up before ordering tickets. In order to give everyone an equal opportunity to get their seats, tickets will be limited December 2nd through December 5th to ten tickets per family. That limitation will be released on December 6th and families needing more seats may go back on line to reserve additional

seats. Please check with family members before December 2nd and only reserve tickets that you know you will be using. THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS FOR TICKETS. If you reserve seats and do not end up needing them please go back to the ticket site and release the seats that you will not be using by December 5th.

In order to be sure there are enough seats for everyone, each family is assigned to **either** the 11:30 a.m. or 2:00 p.m. show. **Please check below to see which show your family is assigned to.** Tickets are good for one show. Families should initially only reserve tickets to one show. After December 5th if you would like to see both shows you can go back and reserve additional tickets, as they are available.

Promptly read and re-read all performance information, Mark your calendar with all rehearsal DATES, TIMES and LOCATIONS.

Arrive on time to all rehearsals and the performance

Bag check WELL BEFORE the performance:

- ☐ Costume-Steamer and any alterations/tacking finished if applicable.
- ☐ Tights- Clean, no holes/runs
- ☐ Hair accessories- include bobby pins, hairspray, hairnets, comb.
- ☐ Ballet shoes/pointe shoes- labeled with your name inside.
- ☐ Make-up- for touch up
- ☐ Safety pins and small sewing kit for emergencies
- ☐ Water bottle
- ☐ Quiet Activity
- ☐ Dancers in both shows: Snack to eat between shows

RECHECK YOUR BAG THE NIGHT BEFORE THE PERFORMANCE
